They are already doing Banana plantation and planning to do various cultivation and enhance their income with the help of this well. I visited in April & August 2016.

Vinothkanthan is a below knee amputee, married with one child, living well below poverty line. In this area wells are very deep and hence very expensive to construct. Agreed to do bore well/tube well at a cost of £700.00. Contractors started the job and they could not reach the water level and hence gave up at no cost. Various other contactors were consulted, and one company agreed to construct an open dug well for £700.00. They had to dig about 60feet to reach the water level. As promised they completed the agreed work. But due to the depth, we paid them £850.00. Letter attached. It's in Tamil.

Dear Chairman and Members of ONE KIND ACT-UK,

We are very sincerely thankful for your generous donation. We managed to construct 10 wells for the disabled people through your donations. We would also like to apologise for the delay in sending this report.

Construction of wells is a difficult task, especially when the beneficiaries are from separate villages. In the first 9 cases, contractors were paid directly for the initial excavation using a machine called Baco by the Rotary club. Money for cement and sand was directly paid to the shops by Rotary club, Mulalitivu. Then the shops delivered these materials to the houses. It was the beneficiaries' responsibilities to find appropriate workers, whom we then paid.

Some of our beneficiaries were very efficient but others were not so. Moreover, some locations had higher labour costs than others. Cost of construction also depended on the width and the depth requirements of the well. Therefore, predicting exact costs proved to be a challenging task. We will post the receipts separately.

Since 2012, CHRF-UK has constructed approximately 700 wells including the above 10. Some wells are still under construction. Even though it is a very expensive project, it is vital that we continue doing it. During our visit to Sri-Lanka in 2016, we witnessed various successful cultivation work by our beneficiaries. We are happy and satisfied with this gift of water which is a basic human right and a lifelong investment.

We would very much appreciate and welcome your continued help in future for the construction of more wells.

We would be more than happy to send you videos of the wells being put into use; however, the explanations are in Tamil. Please let me know if you would like to watch these videos with a brief English description attached.
